Gateway Translations

In 2019, Biblica's Gateway Translation strategy served as a launch pad for accelerating the global reach of God's Word. This year we advanced 36 global Scripture translations, completing two full Bibles and three audio Bibles.

As we practice radical generosity with our translations, God made a way for many of our partner organizations to get the Word into the hands of more of His children. With your partnership, we launched a new Hindi translation, the third most-spoken language in the world with 341 million people calling it their first language. You also helped complete a new contemporary translation in Bengali, the second most-spoken language in India and used by 265 million people in South Asia. Additionally, because of your partnership, 10 translations in Africa are now fully funded and set to reach 158 million people upon completion.

2019 also marked the year in which we opened our Contemporary Arabic Bible to creative commons licensing, freeing it up for exponential deployment by ministry partners. This is already fast-tracking the translation and production of new Scripture texts in 29 regional dialects, opening God's Word in 14 countries across the Middle East reaching language communities of some 200 million people.

Love for the Word Compels Us

Before Mike and Cynthia Richards were even aware of it, God was paving the way for their passion for His Word and to join Him in His plans.

Mike recalls, "The Lord took one little Gideon pocket-sized Bible and it changed our family. It became a miracle that has been impacting our family now, for generations." Mike is referring to the Bible his father was given by a nameless, facelss refinery worker in Port Arthur, Texas in 1949, when Mike was only 11. Prior to that day Mike and his family had no interest in God and were living lives without any spiritual purpose. But after his father received that Bible, small though it was, his family's lives now began to have meaning, and nothing was the same for them again.

It's that passion and determination that have driven the Richards for the past 40 years of Bible engagement. In the mid 80's, Mike was invited to serve on the Board of Living Bibles International, which later merged with the International Bible Society, now known as Biblica. It was in those early years on the board that Mike gained a deeper appreciation of what is required to make readable, understandable translations available around the world.

"In America, most people don't know what it means when we say what is needed to eradicate Bible poverty," says Mike. "The challenge is to translate the Scriptures into peoples' native tongue. When people in other parts of the world read the Bible in English, it's America's Bible. But when they read it in their heart language, it becomes their Bible." The reason the Scripture is so important is because it's the only thing that will last forever.

Over the years, Mike and Cynthia's passion for the Word of God has merged with their life's purpose — exclusively focused on the Bible and seeing it translated, distributed and made available to all those that don't have access to it.

The Richards have had several opportunities to travel with Biblica, but one trip really stood out to them. In Johannesburg, South Africa, they sat in a classroom that was using the *Reach4Life* Bible. With tears of gratitude, the principal told them that since the curriculum had been in use, absenteeism had gone down, teen pregnancy rates had dropped, and test scores were up. It was a living example of God's Word at work.

"The reason the Scripture is so important is because it's the only thing that will last forever. As the prophet Habakkuk says, 'all man's labor is but fuel for the fire' (2:13, NIV). As the Word of God is eternal, so the souls of people are eternal! What better place to invest your money than in the Bible," says Cynthia.

When asked what she wants her legacy to be, Cynthia says, "I want to see the Word of God in the hearts and minds of people, worldwide, leading to salvation and changed lives."

As Mike reflects on the question, he is reminded of the man that gave his father that pocket-sized Gideon Bible. And although that man had no way of knowing the impact his generosity would have on future generations, it is safe to say it is immeasurable. With that in mind, Mike says he simply wants "to be that nameless, faceless American who helped to make the Bible available to people around the world."



Frontline Church

The Church is God's primary agent to reach those on the edges of society. In other words, those that live on the margins — the exploited, the discarded, the overlooked. We call this the "frontline" of the Gospel, or the Frontline Church.

In 2019, this included serving incarcerated men and women in many parts of the world through Biblica's *Free on the Inside Bible*. Your generosity also helped people with disabilities find their worth in God's eyes through resources like the *Accessible Bible*. You also served millions with a hunger for God's Word in the Middle East and North Africa who, despite persecution, received and discovered new hope through contemporary-language Bible resources.

"My Arm Was Sore From Writing..."

When the teams arrived at Sister Li's village church in rural China, with boxes of Bibles, her demeanor vacillated between tears of joy and a radiant smile. At first, she was speechless. Never before had so many Bibles been brought to their village. She knew first-hand the power of the Word, and now so many in her village would have access to it.

Now 79 years of age, she has been a Christian for 40 years. She is what Timothy would refer to as a "widow indeed," someone who lives to serve in the church. One of her primary responsibilities is to teach people how to read her textbook: the Bible.

"Forty years ago, my mother borrowed a Bible," Sister Li told us. "It was hand-written. The only copy we had in our area. My mother was concerned what would happen if it came apart so she encouraged me to copy it as I was the only one in our family who could read. I began the project. I finally completed copying the entire New Testament. When I finished, my arm was so sore...but my heart was full of joy."

As she shared this distant memory, her eyes filled with tears.

Many are coming to faith because of your gifts.

"When I married my husband, he was not a believer. His goal in life was to make as much money as he could in business. I read the Bible to him many times, but he was not interested or convicted of his need for salvation. Then, his business took a severe downturn. He also became quite ill and required my prayers. I told him, now that you cannot go out and make money, you have time to listen to me read

the Bible and explain to you about God. In time, he decided to follow Christ, and accepted Jesus as His Savior."

Sister Li smiled wide as she went on, "His priorities and his purpose were forever changed. Finally, my home was a Christian home because of the Bible. My husband realized when you follow money you will ultimately fail. Only in Christ do we find meaning."

But Sister Li's struggle is not over. "Now my husband has passed away and I am alone here on this farm, but the Bible is still my life. With the new Bibles given to us, I can hold a class in our village church to teach others how to read the Bible. Not only that, by growing crops in my garden I can share with neighbors. Then they also listen to me as I read to them the truth of God's Word. I have two Bible ministries. One in the church and one outside."

Thank you for opening God's Word to so many local heroes like Sister Li. As she shared in her own words, "Many are coming to faith because of your gifts."



210 Years of God's Radical Generosity

1809 The beginning:

1800's

Manhattan, the heart of New York City, is the birthplace of the ministry — first called The New York Bible Society.



Serving the imprisoned: New York Bible Society

organized volunteers from local churches to distribute Bibles and New Testaments to 25,000 prisoners in the boroughs of New York City.



1865

Serving Civil War Soldiers:

By the end of the Civil War, Bible Society volunteers had distributed nearly 300,000 Bibles and New Testaments to soldiers. The final Civil War distribution was to confederate prisoners, released from prison in Elmira, New York, to return to their homes in the South.



1892 Reaching the Nations through Ellis Island:

When Ellis Island opened for immigration, a New York Bible Society representative was on the first ferry transporting workers to the facility. As millions of immigrants came into the United States, our agents offered Scriptures in up to 65 different languages.



1920 First Bibles for the Blind: The New York Bible Society is the first to publish the Bible in Braille.



1952 Mass Bible Distribution during the Billy Graham Crusades:

The Bible Society provided Scriptures for Billy Graham's New York crusade at Madison Square Garden.

Billy Graham preached to a crowd in front of a New York Bible Society poster in a New York subway station.

1978 Radical Decisions to make way for the NIV:

In the 1970s the Bible Society sold their building for \$1 million to help pay for the translation of the New International Version (NIV) Bible. The translation was published and first released in limited distribution in 1973 and then for mass distribution in 1978.

Partnering with YouVersion:

When Apple's App Store launched in 2008, YouVersion was one of the first 100 apps. Biblica freely offered the NIV translation through YouVersion on its very first day.

Biblica's *Reach4Life* program hit the monumental goal of reaching more than 2 million youth with the Gospel.

Digital Impact

Following Christ's command to freely give as we have freely received, we are looking for every way we can to get our Scripture texts freely deployed for those who need them. Often, this means lifting licensing restrictions and legal barriers. It also includes digitally downloading our texts for free. For example, through YouVersion alone, our texts are downloaded 481 million times per month!

As of 2019, we have made 69 translations of the Bible available in digital and 28 translations available in audio formats. The response to this continues to be astounding. In this last year, we saw a 30 percent increase in both Scripture requests and audio requests within the digital platforms of YouVersion and Bible Gateway. With the use of cross-platform and multimedia Scripture resources (print, audio, digital, video, and immersive technologies), **the gap between those who need it and the Word is closing.**

We also experienced 145 percent increase in visits to our website, Biblica.com. In this last year, 27 million people engaged with Bible stories and studies on our site, more than doubling the previous year's 11 million visitors.

Digital Innovations in 2019

We are thrilled to leverage today's technology to expand the reach of God's Word for people around the world. We invite you to pray with us for our three current ministry initiatives:

Digital Training Library: Biblica, in collaboration with Fuller Theological Seminary, is pioneering a Digital Training Library platform for the entire global translation community. This first-of-its-kind, online training platform will help tackle the number one bottleneck within Bible translation: strengthening mother-tongue translators and consultants to move global projects to completion.

Rural Digital Engagement: We are also partnering with new technology to serve the two billion people in rural communities across the globe without reliable access to digital Scripture content. Leveraging the patented technology of a partner, we will transfer the experience of Scripture apps for new Gospel engagement on low-end, entry-level mobile devices. This technology is planned to launch in 2021.

Open.Bible: Biblica launched the open.bible website, trailblazing Creative Commons licensing for mission partners to engage open licensed Bible texts and audio. Just by unlocking our Contemporary Arabic Bible, we are seeing a powerful acceleration for new Arabic dialect translation and millions to gain new engagement with God's Word in their heart language.

Rising Generations

The Scriptures are clear about God's heart for children and youth. As we pursue the heart of our radically generous God, reaching the Rising Generations is core to Biblica's DNA.

Thanks to you and our ministry partners, Biblica's *The Survivors: Kids in Tough Places* has now been translated into six languages, bringing much needed hope to thousands of traumatized children.

Our *Reach4Life* New Testament continues to expand, adding 5 more languages this last year, and impacting 323,842 youth. Through your support, new peer educator trainings were held this year in the Philippines and Thailand.

Add to this another 267,432 children and teens who experienced the love of Jesus through the reach of Bible resources, like *Game of Life* and *Adventure Bible*.

In the community of Carabuela, Ecuador, 10-year old Joaquín lives with his five brothers and mother. His story is tragically typical for this region, having a father who abandoned him when he was very young. Generally, the parents of these children migrate abroad to find new opportunities and are left with older, remaining relatives. So while kids like Joaquin should be playing with friends, they are forced to work in the fields, sowing corn, harvesting fruit, doing whatever they can to keep their families afloat.

On a sunny Monday, life changed for Joaquin. Biblica, working in partnership with both Compassion International and Samaritan's Purse, arrived with much needed hope for this community. Joaquin was one of the 300 children about to receive shoeboxes filled with toys and a special copy of the Word of God.

Joaquin was also served by our partnership with Compassion, inviting the love of Jesus and God's Word to go far deeper within his life. So on this Monday, Joaquin stood stunned. Grateful, he approached the team and hugged every one of them. Our translator shared with us Joaquin's rushed words, "Thank you. Joaquín says thank you in his Quichua language."
